contrast (verb)

Definition: to find what is different between things

Use morphemes to comprehend:

trast con

contra = 'against' stare = 'stand' (from Latin) (from Latin)

con + trast =

to stand (hold) one thing against another and find differences

I had to contrast women's rights before and after the war.
