

Why teach kids to read with decodable books?

Because decodable books:

- **Provide a purpose for learning phonics:**
We learn phonics in order to read a fun story.
- **Offer practice of phonics:**
Kids read texts embedded with the phonics they have already been taught.
- **Develop good reading strategies based on the Science of Reading:**
Sounding out the graphemes and blending them into words—not guessing!
- **Offer an experience of reading success:**
A text with controlled words, based on phonics previously taught, provides instant success.
- **Create motivation:**
Success brings motivation to continue learning to read—
“I can do this!”
- **Develop independence:**
Kids learn to work out words for themselves.
