- Develop good reading strategies based on the Science of Reading:
 Sounding out the graphemes and blending them into words—not guessing!
- Offer an experience of reading success:
 A text with controlled words, based on phonics previously taught, provides instant success.
- Create motivation:
 Success brings motivation to continue learning to read—"I can do this!"
- <u>Develop independence:</u>
 Kids learn to work out words for themselves.
